2 Selective Funding, Bigger Bets



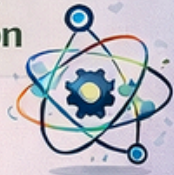
- Funding recovering but more concentrated & cautious

4 Rise of DeepTech & Sovereign Innovation



- Quantum, AI, semiconductors gaining push
- State-led initiatives (e.g. Quantum ecosystem programs)
- Shift from SaaS to IP-led innovation
